ALUMINUM STRUCTURES & SPECIALTIES

A contractor whose services consist of the installation, fabrication, maintenance (except for cleaning), repair or design with aluminum, vinyl and fiberglass screen material. The aluminum contractor may work on foundation, slabs on grade and block knee walls, wood decks (self-standing) and utility sheds (wood studs only) less than 501 square feet, necessary to and incidental to the aluminum construction work. The aluminum contractor shall not perform any work that alters the structural integrity of the building and shall not use wood products for rafters, trusses and wood beams.

AWNING ERECTION AE

Awning Erection Category-Class "AE": The scope of work of a Class "AE" specialty building contractor shall include and be limited to the fabrication, erection, and installation of awnings and canopies which become a permanent fixed part of building or structure or which are self-supporting, and the pouring of such footings and slabs on grade as may be necessary and incidental thereto. A Class "AE" specialty building contractor may install such hardware as may be necessary and incidental to the extension and retraction of awnings and canopies. This category applies to awnings that are movable or retractable or the replacement of detachable cloth/synthetic cover material on existing frames. Electrical wiring incidental to the awning may be included in the contract for work, but shall be subcontracted to a licensed electrical contractor. This category includes, but is not limited to, metal, canvas, and storm shutters. In order to be eligible to be certified as a Class "AE" specialty building contractor by the board, the applicant shall have at least three (3) years of practical experience in the category.

BUILDING CONTRACTOR (ENGLISH & SPANISH)

Building Contractor means a contractor whose services are limited to construction of commercial and single-dwelling or multiple-dwelling residential buildings, which commercial or residential buildings do not exceed three stories in height, and accessory use structures in connection therewith or a contractor whose services are limited to remodeling, repair, or improvement of any size building if the services do not affect the structural members of the building. As regulated under Florida Statute, a person who has passed a competency examination as a Building Contractor may perform these or related tasks or may supervise persons in his employ in the execution of these tasks.

COMMERCIAL SWIMMING POOL

Shall include the construction, repair, water treatment, and servicing of any swimming pool or hot tub or spa, whether public or private or otherwise, regardless of use. The scope of such work includes layout, excavation, operation of construction pumps for dewatering purposes, steelwork, installation of light niches, construction of floors, guniting, fiber glassing, installation of tile and coping, installation of all perimeter and filter piping, installation of all filter equipment and chemical feeders of any type, plastering of the interior, construction of decks (slabs incidental to the pool), construction of equipment rooms or housing for pool equipment, and installation of package pool heaters. (However, the scope of work of such Contractor shall not include direct connections to a sanitary sewer or to potable water lines.) Such Contractors may contract for screen enclosures if a sublicensed specialist performs such work, and contracted with pool work.

DIRECT BURIAL CABLE TELEVISION (CATV) CONTRACTOR 2017

A Direct Burial Cable Television (CATV) Contractor is an engineering contractor certified by this Board to trench, backfill, and restore paving and concrete block and cement work either incidental to or as a part of the work of installing, repairing, altering or adding to any system of underground cable in the public rights-of-way for the commercial transmission of television signals. Such contractor shall have a qualifying agent with experience and skill gained by at least two (2) years' practical work in this field and who has passed an examination approved by this Board. The scope of work of this classification shall be limited to that work directly involved in performing contract work underground for direct burial of cable for receiving and transmitting community antenna television signals. (Ord. No. 81-43, § 1, 4-21-81)

MASTER MECHANICAL

Master Mechanical shall mean any person whose services are unlimited in the execution of contracts requiring the experience, knowledge, and skill to perform the following; install maintain, repair, fabricate, alter, extend or design (when not prohibited by law) central air conditioning, refrigeration, heating and ventilation (including duct work in connection with a complete system only to the extent such duct work is performed by the Contractor necessary to make complete an air distribution system) boiler and unfired pressure vessel systems, lift stations, equipment and piping and all appurtenances, apparatus, or equipment used in connection therewith; also piping, insulation of pipes, vessels and ducts, pressure and process piping, pneumatic control piping, gasoline tanks and pump installation and piping for same, fire sprinkling systems and standpipes, air piping, vacuum line piping, oxygen lines, nitrous oxide piping, ink and chemical lines, fuel transmission lines and installation of a condensate drain from an air conditioning unit to an existing safe waste or other approved disposal other than a direct connection to a sanitary system, all in such a manner to comply with all plans, specifications, codes, laws and regulations applicable thereto. The scope of work for such Contractor shall not include any work such as liquefied petroleum or natural gas fuel lines within buildings, potable waterlines or connections thereto, sanitary sewer lines, swimming pool piping and filters and electrical power wiring.

RESIDENTIAL CONTRACTOR

ROOFING (ENGLISH & SPANISH)

A Roofing Contractor is a contractor qualified and certified to install, repair and replace roof systems, as defined in the South Florida Building Code, and the waterproofing thereof. Work may include, but shall not be limited to, roof deck insulation, roof coating, painting and covering, including use of sheet metal and installation of other sheet metal products incidental to roofing work, including gutters and downspouts, and other material in connection therewith or any combination thereof and including installation of nonstructural decking and siding. During the repair or replacement process of a roof system, a roofing contractor shall be allowed to repair and/or replace damaged decking and/or damaged wood structural or nonstructural members of the roof framing, provided that such replacement and/or repair conforms to the requirements of the South Florida Building Code and the repair or replacement of damaged decking and wood structural or nonstructural members of the roof framing constitutes less than fifty (50) percent of the value of the total work performed.
